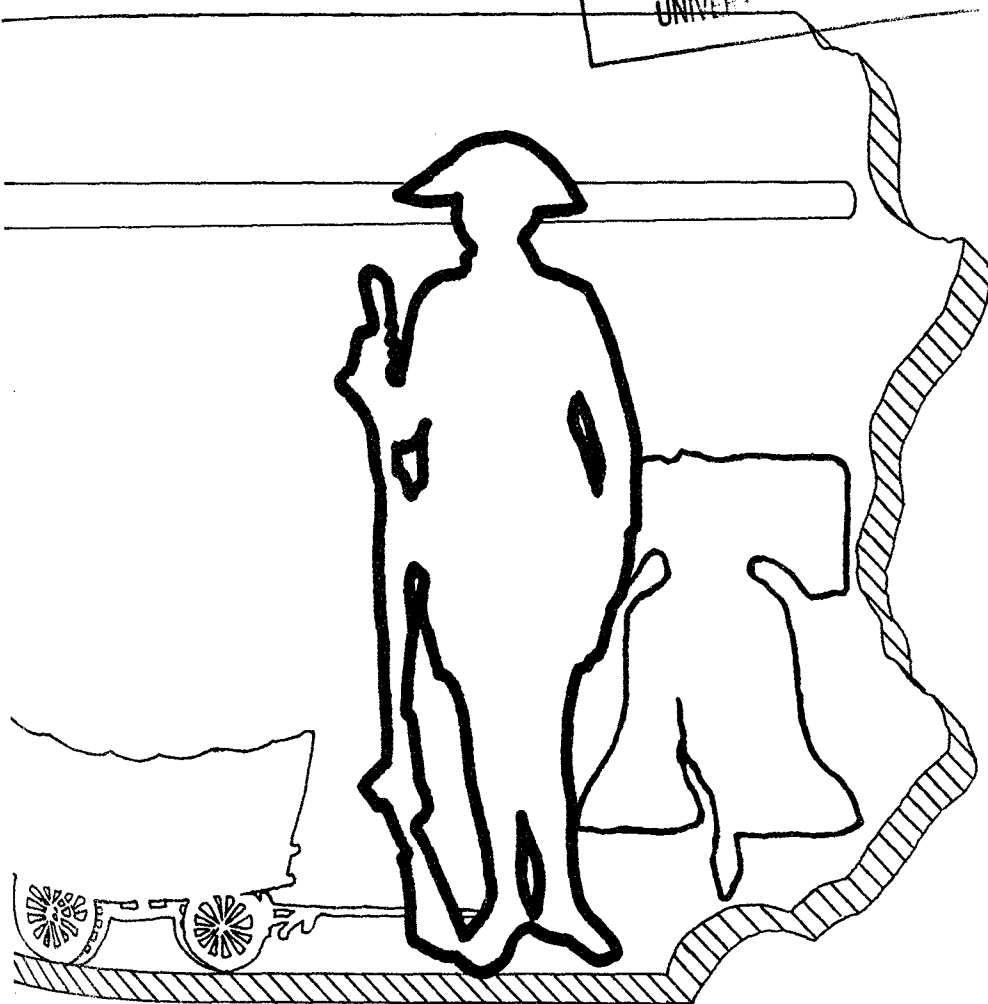
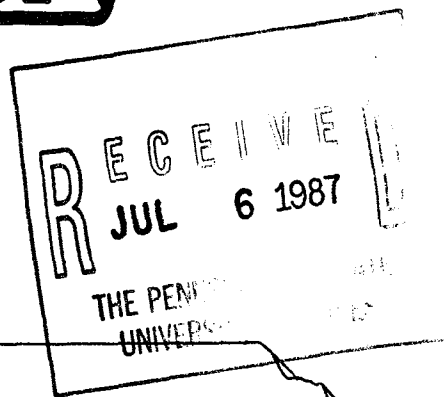

Manuscripts must be submitted in two copies and should conform with the University of Chicago *Manual of Style*. Footnotes should be double-spaced and placed at the end of the manuscript.
