She writes articles that have appeared in the *U.S. Women Engineer* and *Initiatives*. Emily has given presentations at the following conferences: WEPAN, ASEE, Frontiers in Education, American Psychological Association, American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy, and the National Council on Family Relations. Dr. Wadsworth is an Ex-officio member of the WEPAN Board of Directors and Chairperson of WEPAN's Action Group on Research, Evaluation, and Dissemination (AGRED). In these roles she has edited *College Classroom Climate Resources* and the *1995 WEPAN DATA BOOK of Women in Engineering Programs*.
