Sandler is a Senior Scholar in Residence at the National Association for Women in Education (NAWE), where she consults with colleges about achieving equity for women on campus, and edits a quarterly newsletter, *About Women on Campus*. Dr. Sandler has a long list of firsts, such as first reports on campus sexual harassment, gang rape, campus peer harassment, and a series on the chilly climate for women, including the first report on how men and women are treated differently in the classroom. She played a major role in the development and passage of Title IX. She has served on more than thirty boards, has nine honorary doctorates and has received numerous awards.
