Sossina M. Haile received a Bachelor of Science degree in Materials Science and Engineering from Massachusetts Institute of Technology, a Master of Science degree from the University of California, Berkeley and later returned to MIT to obtain her Ph.D. Sossina subsequently obtained a position at the University of Washington as an assistant professor and recently moved to California where she is an assistant professor at California Institute of Technology.

Dr. Haile received the Hardy Award in 1997 for exceptional promise of a successful career in materials science and the National Young Investigator Award from NSF to investigate solid electrolytes. As a post-doctoral student, she was named a Fullbright and Humboldt Fellow, conducting research at the Max-Planck-Institut für Festkörperforschung in Stuttgart, Germany.
