

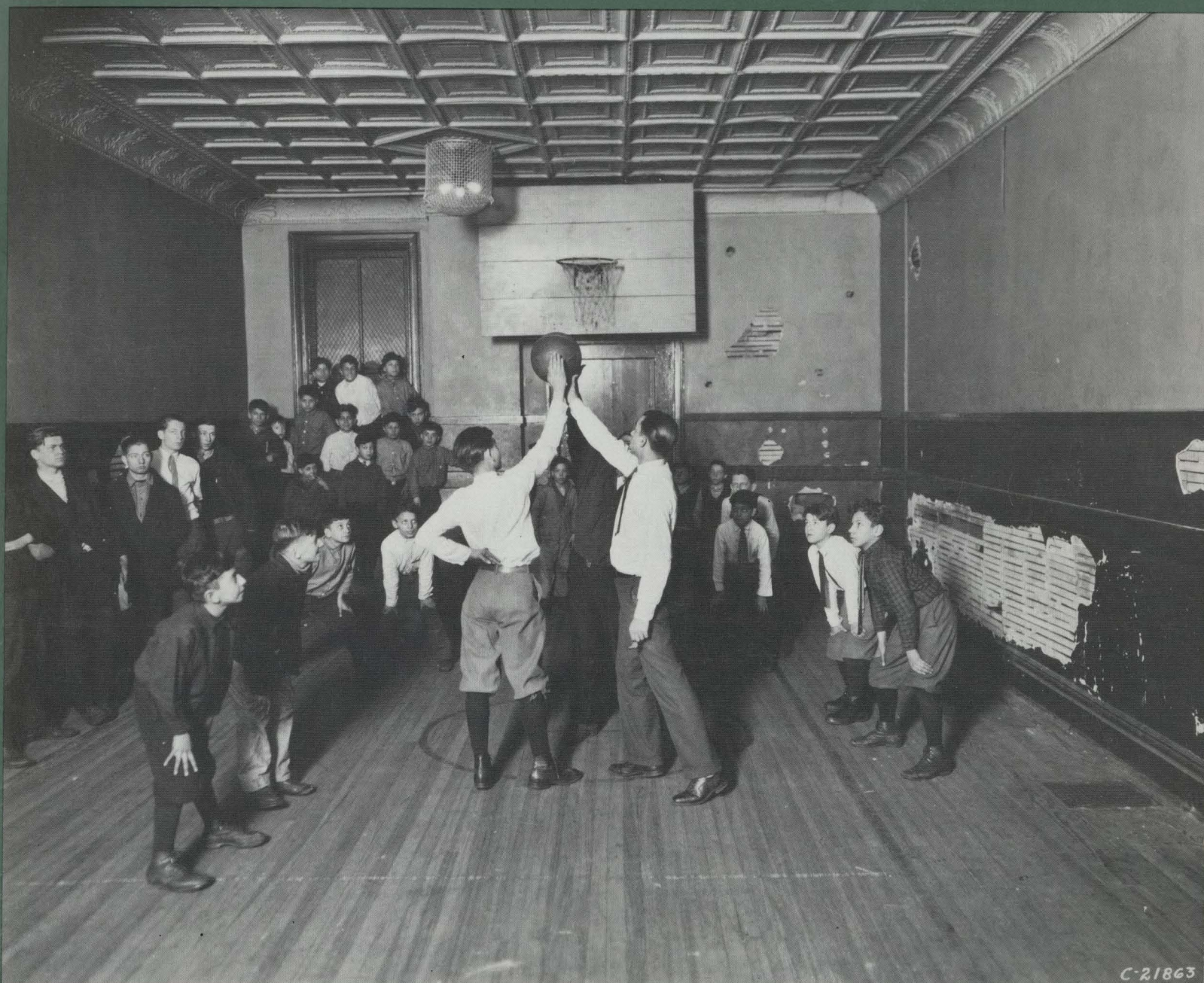

**T**HE Historical Society of Western Pennsylvania is a nonprofit cultural institution open to the public. Since its founding in 1879, the Society has collected, preserved, and interpreted the heritage of Pittsburgh and its region. It operates Library & Archives, Museum Programs, and Advancement divisions, and manages the Meadowcroft Museum of Rural Life, a living history museum in Washington County, under a joint

operating agreement. In 1996, the Society will open a new 160,000 square-foot facility, the Pittsburgh Regional History Center, near downtown Pittsburgh.

**Membership:** Membership is open to anyone interested in the Society's goals and activities. Classes of annual membership and dues are as follows: Student, \$20; Individual, \$30; Family, \$40; Organization, \$50; Patron, \$100; Friend, \$250; Benefactor, \$500. Membership includes free admission

to the Society's museum and library, quarterly issues of Pittsburgh History and the Society's newsletter, invitation to the new members' reception and special members-only events, the Society's annual report, and discounts on tours, lectures, films, gift items, and other services.

**Hours:** Tuesday through Saturday, 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. A donation is requested for admission. Group tours are available by appointment.
