The Historical Society operates the Senator John Heinz Pittsburgh Regional History Center with Library & Archives, Museum, Public Programs, Advancement, Marketing, and Business divisions, and manages the Meadowcroft Museum of Rural Life, a living history museum in Washington County, under a joint operating agreement.
