The Story of Negro League Baseball: We Are the Ship

Through August 26, 2012

With baseball season underway, the Western Pennsylvania Sports Museum presents an exciting new exhibition, *The Story of Negro League Baseball: We Are the Ship*, sponsored by the Double Eagle Foundation, the Fine Foundation, and the Pittsburgh Pirates.

This powerful 2,500-square-foot exhibition tells the story of the Negro Leagues through nearly 50 original paintings and sketches by award-winning artist and author Kadir Nelson. The paintings provide a personal look at the ballplayers who became larger-than-life, transcended baseball, and set the stage for the modern Civil Rights Movement.

The exhibition includes a special section on the Negro League baseball tradition in Pittsburgh, including a rare uniform and artifacts from the Western Pennsylvania Sports Museum collection.

A new lifelike figure of baseball legend Josh Gibson, the Hall of Fame slugger who starred for the Homestead Grays and Pittsburgh Crawfords, will be unveiled as part of this exhibit.
