

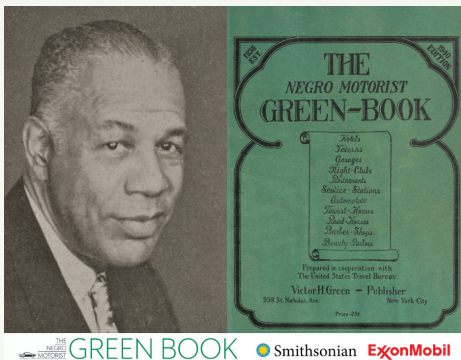
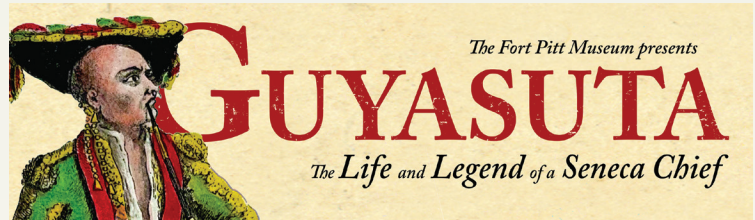

Guyasuta: The Life and Legend of a Seneca Chief

Now open at Fort Pitt through September 4, 2023.

The Fort Pitt Museum's exhibition, *Guyasuta: The Life and Legend of a Seneca Chief*, follows the Seneca leader's tireless defense of his people from the French & Indian War through the American Revolution. The exhibit includes a bronze maquette of Jim West's iconic *Point of View* sculpture of Guyasuta and George Washington, an 18th-century war club and pipe tomahawk, and other artifacts used by American Indians in the Ohio Country.



The Negro Motorist Green Book

Open through August 13, 2023.

Developed by the Smithsonian Institution Traveling Exhibition Service in collaboration with award-winning author, photographer, and cultural documentarian Candacy Taylor, this exhibition offers an immersive look at the harsh reality of mid-century travel for African Americans and how the annual guide served as an indispensable resource for the nation's rising African American middle class.
